




## ANKLE PROTECTOR - PG2/E

### TECHNICAL

This garment has been designed to give a specified level of protection against accidental contact with blades and similar sharp implements. In the design of this garment due respect has been paid to the basic health and safety requirements laid out in PPE regulation (EU) 2016/425. The garment has been tested in accordance with standard EN 388: 2016.

Each pair of protectors consists of left- and right-handed units. The protector should be fastened firmly around the ankle and lower leg so that it is not able to ride up the leg and expose the ankle to hazards.

### GARMENT CARE:

New and used garments should be thoroughly inspected, especially after cleaning, to ensure no damage is present. Stored garments should be kept in a dry place away from heat and direct sunlight. This garment can be disposed of/recycled in the same way as normal textile fabrics/garments.

Clean with a damp sponge if required.

**REPAIR:** Do not repair this garment.
