



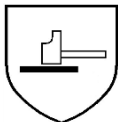

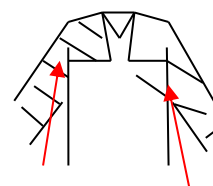
PROTECTIVE SLEEVES - PG2/C & PROTECTIVE JACKET - PG2/D
