
TECHNICAL

USE.

These garments are for the intended use within the glass industry.

New and used garments should be thoroughly inspected before use to ensure no damage is present. THESE GARMENTS ARE DESIGNED TO GIVE PROTECTION TO THE OUTER SIDE OF THE LEG ONLY. WHERE THERE IS ANY RISK OF CUTS TO THE INSIDE OF THE LEG THE GARMENT MUST BE WORN IN CONJUNCTION WITH A SUITABLE CUT RESISTANT APRON SUCH AS DALE TECHNICHE'S STYLE PG2/A. A SUITABLE APRON MUST BE WORN IN CONJUNCTION WITH STYLE PG3/B TROUSERS WHERE THERE IS ANY RISK TO THE UPPER LEG.

GARMENT CARE.

The test results for the garment were achieved after 5 washes. Stored garments should be kept in their original packaging in a dry place away from heat and direct sunlight. Hand or machine wash in water not exceeding 40°C using a good proprietary washing powder or detergent. <u>Do not use</u> <u>bleach</u>, Line dry or dry flat. <u>Do not tumble dry</u>. The garment can be ironed with a medium iron if necessary. Failure to observe the above instructions and aggressive or repeated washing may affect the mechanical or EN388 performance of the garment.
